MAP's DISASTER RESPONSE

Phase 1: During bombardment – Immediate medical supplies

- MAP is on the ground and in constant contact with the hospitals delivering medical supplies where they are needed most.
- We are coordinating with other international aid agencies to ensure that we are all able to deliver humanitarian relief where it is needed most without duplicating work.
- MAP's emergency hygiene kits, blankets and mattresses have been distributed to families who have lost their homes.
- We plan for emergencies. Our emergency care and serious burns training for doctors and nurses in Gaza, as well as refurbishment of burns treatment centres, have significantly improved the life chances of those seriously injured.

Phase 2: When the bombing stops - Recovery, rehabilitation and readiness

- The damage sustained by Gaza to hospitals, infrastructure and homes in addition to the shortages of medical supplies, fuel and a safe water supply - is a major risk to the population.
- MAP has an established network with the hospitals and community organisations to ensure we reach the most vulnerable, many of them very young children.
- Coming to terms with the destruction and loss of life will be profoundly difficult for many people.
- Medical Aid for Palestinians has a permanent team based in Gaza we will be there to help people rebuild their lives.
